CONSERVATION REPORT CARD

The Defenders of Wildlife Action Fund's *2005-2006 Conservation Report Card* measures the commitment of U.S. Senators and Representatives to wildlife and habitat conservation during the 109th Congress. It reviews 20 House votes and 11 Senate votes on key conservation issues, providing a clear assessment of how well members of Congress are protecting wildlife and wild lands for future generations.

The *2005-2006 Conservation Report Card* covers votes on issues including drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, reauthorizing the Endangered Species Act, maintaining protections for wildlife along America's borders and safeguarding our coastal waters from oil and gas exploration and drilling.

SENATE Key Issues and Votes

1. Halting a Backdoor Attack on Arctic Wildlife

By a razor-thin margin, the Senate supported a backdoor scheme to authorize drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge through the federal budget process. The Senate defeated an amendment that would have removed the drilling provision from the budget. (**March 16, 2005, Roll Call No. 52**)

2. Stopping Conservation Funding Cuts

The Senate passed a budget resolution for 2006 that would significantly cut funding for conservation and the environment and take the first step in authorizing drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. (**March 17, 2005, Roll Call No. 81**)

3. Blocking Arctic Drilling and Budget Cuts

The Senate passed a final budget resolution that included a backdoor scheme that would pave the way for drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and significantly cut funding for conservation and the environment.

(**April 28, 2005, Roll Call No. 114**)

4. Rejecting a Damaging Coastal Oil Inventory

The Senate rejected an amendment that would have protected our coastal waters from disruptive and damaging seismic oil and gas surveys and instead included a provision that would undermine an existing ban on oil and gas drilling in U.S. coastal waters. (**June 21, 2005, Roll Call No. 143**)

5. Protecting Wildlife in Tongass National Forest

The Senate defeated an amendment that would have stopped the construction of damaging logging roads at taxpayer expense in Alaska's pristine Tongass National Forest.

(**June 29, 2005, Roll Call No. 164**)

6. Challenging Shortsighted Energy Policy

The Senate passed an energy bill that would fail to reduce America's dependence on oil, address the threat of global warming, make any new investments in clean energy and, by the President's own admission, would not help consumers at the gas pump. The bill also includes a provision that would allow seismic airgun oil and gas surveys along our nation's coastline. (**July 29, 2005, Roll Call No. 213**)

7. Fighting an Attempt to Allow Arctic Drilling

The Senate passed a budget reconciliation bill that included language that would allow drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. (**November 3, 2005, Roll Call No. 303**)

8. Thwarting a Sneak Attack on the Arctic Refuge

The Senate thwarted an attempt to add a provision to the Department of Defense spending bill that would allow drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge.

(**December 21, 2005, Roll Call No. 364**)

9. Restoring Conservation Programs

The Senate rejected an amendment to the 2007 Senate budget resolution that would have restored funding for conservation and environmental protection programs.

(**May 16, 2006, Roll Call No. 60**)

10. Opposing Drilling in the Gulf

The Senate voted to move forward with a bill that would undermine longstanding drilling bans by significantly expanding drilling in the western Gulf of Mexico. (**July 31, 2006, Roll Call No. 218**)

11. Securing Southern Borderlands Habitat

The Senate approved a bill that would require the construction of more than 700 miles of double-layer fencing that would have severe impacts on wildlife and habitat along the U.S. border with Mexico. (**September 29, 2006, Roll Call No. 262**)

1. Protecting Borderlands Wildlife

The House defeated an amendment that would have prohibited the secretary of the Department of Homeland Security from waiving all U.S. laws, including environmental laws, in the construction of walls, fences, roads and other barriers along U.S. borders. (**February 10, 2005, Roll Call No. 29**)

2. Stopping Conservation Funding Cuts I

The House passed a budget resolution for 2006 that would significantly cut funding for conservation and the environment. (**March 17, 2005, Roll Call No. 88**)

3. Halting Arctic Refuge Drilling

The House rejected an amendment that would have protected the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge from oil drilling. (**April 20, 2005, Roll Call No. 122**)

4. Blocking Arctic Drilling and Budget Cuts

The House passed a federal budget resolution that included a backdoor scheme that would pave the way for drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and significantly cut funding for conservation and the environment. (**April 28, 2005, Roll Call No. 149**)

5. Challenging Shortsighted Energy Policy

The House passed an energy bill that would fail to reduce America's dependence on oil, address the threat of global warming, make any new investments in clean energy and, by the President's own admission, would not help consumers at the gas pump. The bill also includes a provision that would allow seismic airgun oil and gas surveys along our nation's coastline. (**July 28, 2005, Roll Call No. 445**)

6. Upholding Endangered Species Protections

The House failed to pass an alternative bipartisan substitute to the reckless Threatened and Endangered Species Recovery Act introduced by Rep. Richard W. Pombo (R-CA) and labeled the Pombo Wildlife Extinction Bill by the conservation community. (**September 29, 2005, Roll Call No. 505**)

7. Opposing the Pombo Wildlife Extinction Bill

The House passed Rep. Richard W. Pombo's bill that would significantly weaken the landmark 1973 Endangered Species Act. (**September 29, 2005, Roll Call No. 506**)

8. Blocking the "No Relief" Energy Act

The House passed supplemental energy legislation that would harm wildlife, public lands and public health instead of offering solutions to consumers and businesses hard hit by rising gasoline prices and winter heating costs. (**October 7, 2005, Roll Call No. 519**)

9. Thwarting a Sneak Attack on the Arctic Refuge

The House voted to approve a rule that allowed the inclusion of language in the Department of Defense Appropriations Bill that would legalize drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. (**December 19, 2005, Roll Call No. 666**)

10. Supporting Laws That Protect Forest Wildlife

The House defeated an amendment that would have required the Forest Service to comply with environmental protection, endangered species and historic preservation laws when conducting post-disturbance salvage logging operations in America's national forests. (**May 17, 2006, Roll Call No. 147**)

11. Defending Forests Against Salvage Logging

The House passed legislation that would encourage damaging salvage logging operations after natural disturbances in America's national forests. (**May 17, 2006, Roll Call No. 151**)

12. Stopping Conservation Funding Cuts II

The House passed a budget resolution for 2007 that would significantly cut funding for conservation and the environment. (**May 18, 2006, Roll Call No. 158**)

13. Protecting Habitat in Tongass National Forest

For the second time in three years, the House passed an amendment that would protect important wildlife habitat by stopping taxpayer-subsidized logging road construction in Tongass National Forest, America's rain forest.

14. Restoring Wetlands Habitat Protection

The House approved an amendment that would safeguard long-standing clean water protections for many small streams, wetlands, lakes and ponds. (May 18, 2006, Roll Call No. 169)

15. Keeping the Offshore Drilling Moratorium

The House passed an amendment to the Interior Appropriations bill that would maintain the 25-year bipartisan moratorium on offshore natural gas drilling.

(May 18, 2006, Roll Call No. 170)

16. Preventing Natural Resource Program Cuts

The House passed an Interior and Environment funding bill for 2007 that includes some of the lowest funding levels in years for public lands, wildlife and habitat conservation.

17. Fighting Against Arctic Refuge Drilling

The House passed a freestanding bill that would allow drilling for oil in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge.

(May 25, 2006, Roll Call No. 209)

18. Opposing the Pombo Coastal Drilling Bill

The House voted for an amendment that would lift the 25-year bipartisan moratorium on offshore drilling and replace it with weak protections for our coasts, marine wildlife and oceans from the pollution associated with oil and gas drilling.

(June 29, 2006, Roll Call No. 356)

19. Securing Southern Borderlands Habitat

The House approved a bill that would require the construction of more than 700 miles of double-layer fencing that could have severe impacts on wildlife and habitat along the U.S. border with Mexico. (September 14, 2006, Roll Call No. 446)

20. Maintaining Local Wildlife Protections

The House passed legislation that would make it more difficult for local communities to protect local wildlife habitat and to set aside parks and open space.

(September 29, 2006, Roll Call No. 511)
